- Edexcel BTEC Level 2 Certificate in Hospitality and Catering Principles (Professional Cookery) (QCF) - knowledge component
- Functional Skill in Maths L1
- Functional Skill in English L1
- ERR (Employee Rights and Responsibilities) and PLTS (Personal Learning and Thinking Skills) requirements are embedded in to the Diploma.

BTEC Level 3 Advanced Apprenticeship in Craft Cuisine:

- Edexcel Level 3 Diploma in Craft Cuisine (QCF) - competency component
